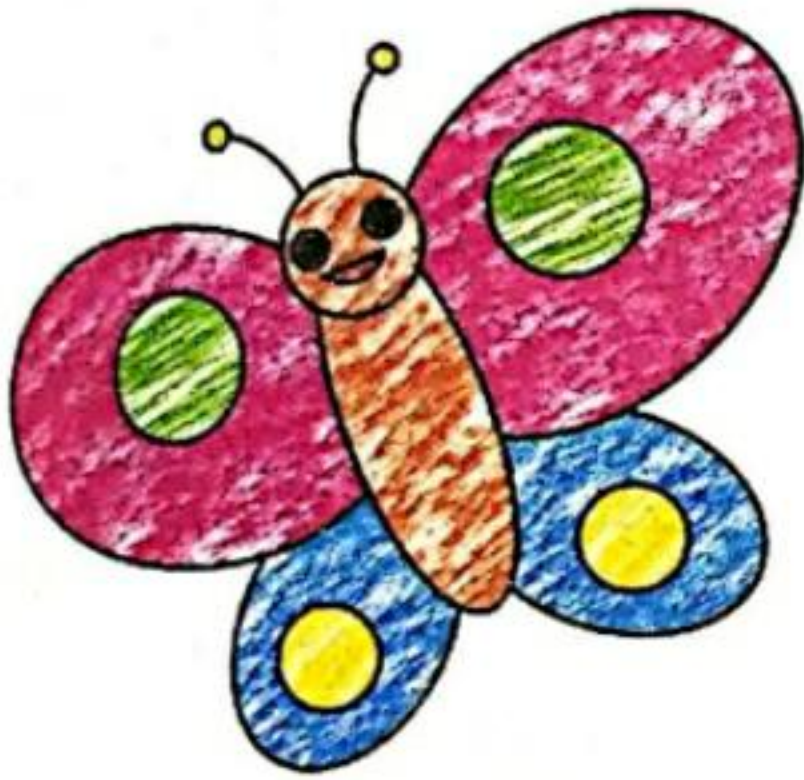

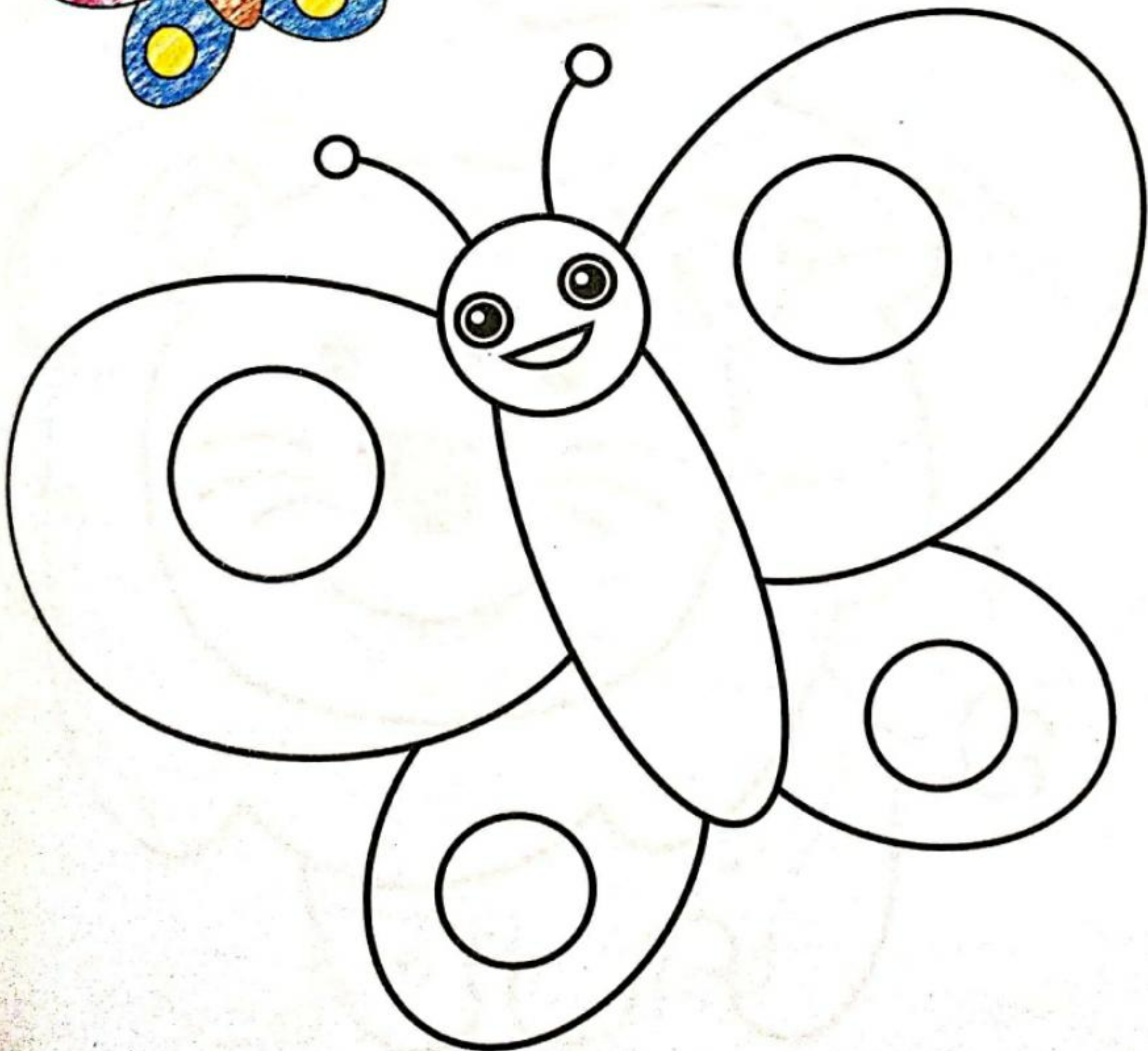
COLOURFUL BUTTERFLY

Colour the lion with crayons, as shown:



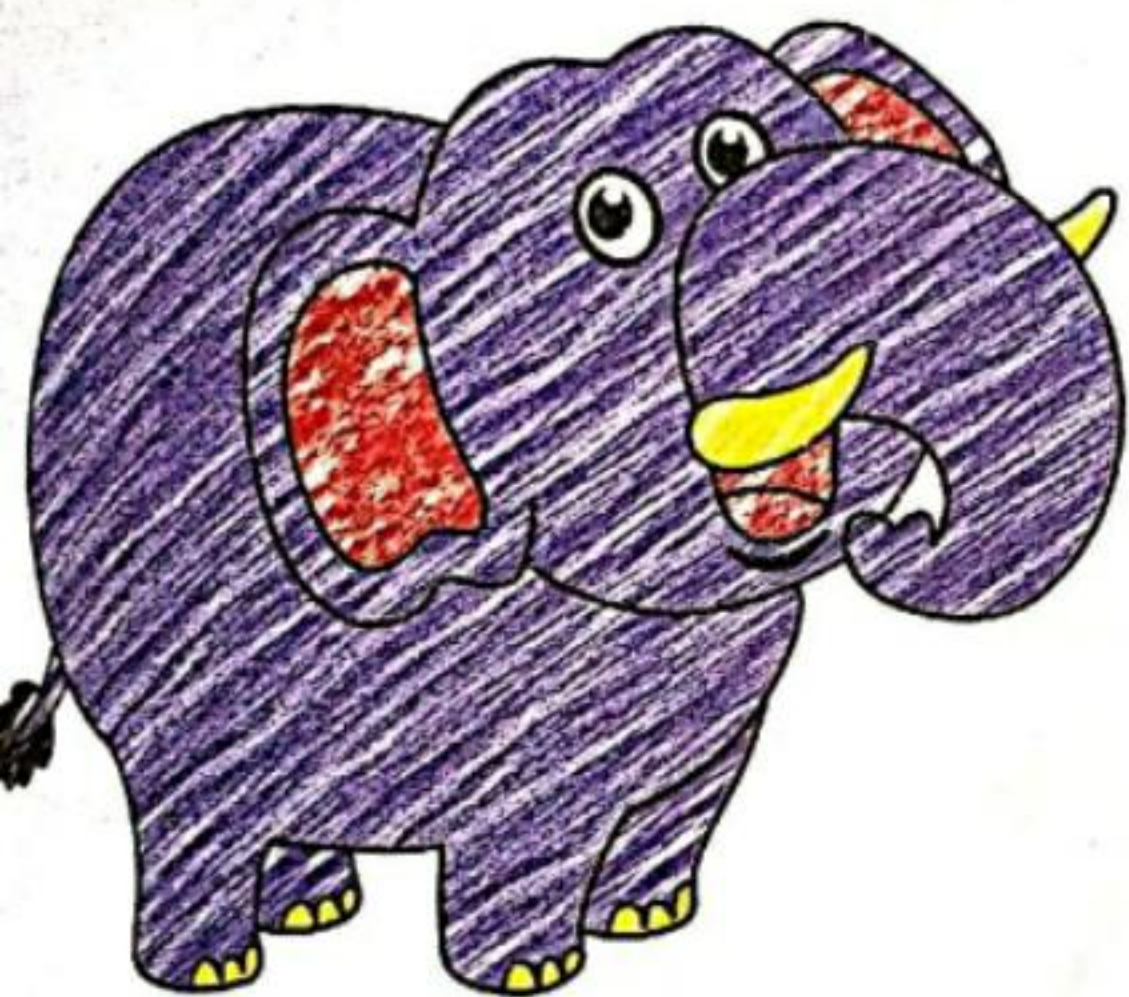
Brain Box

Lions are big cats known as the "king of the jungle". The scientific name for lions is 'panthera leo'.



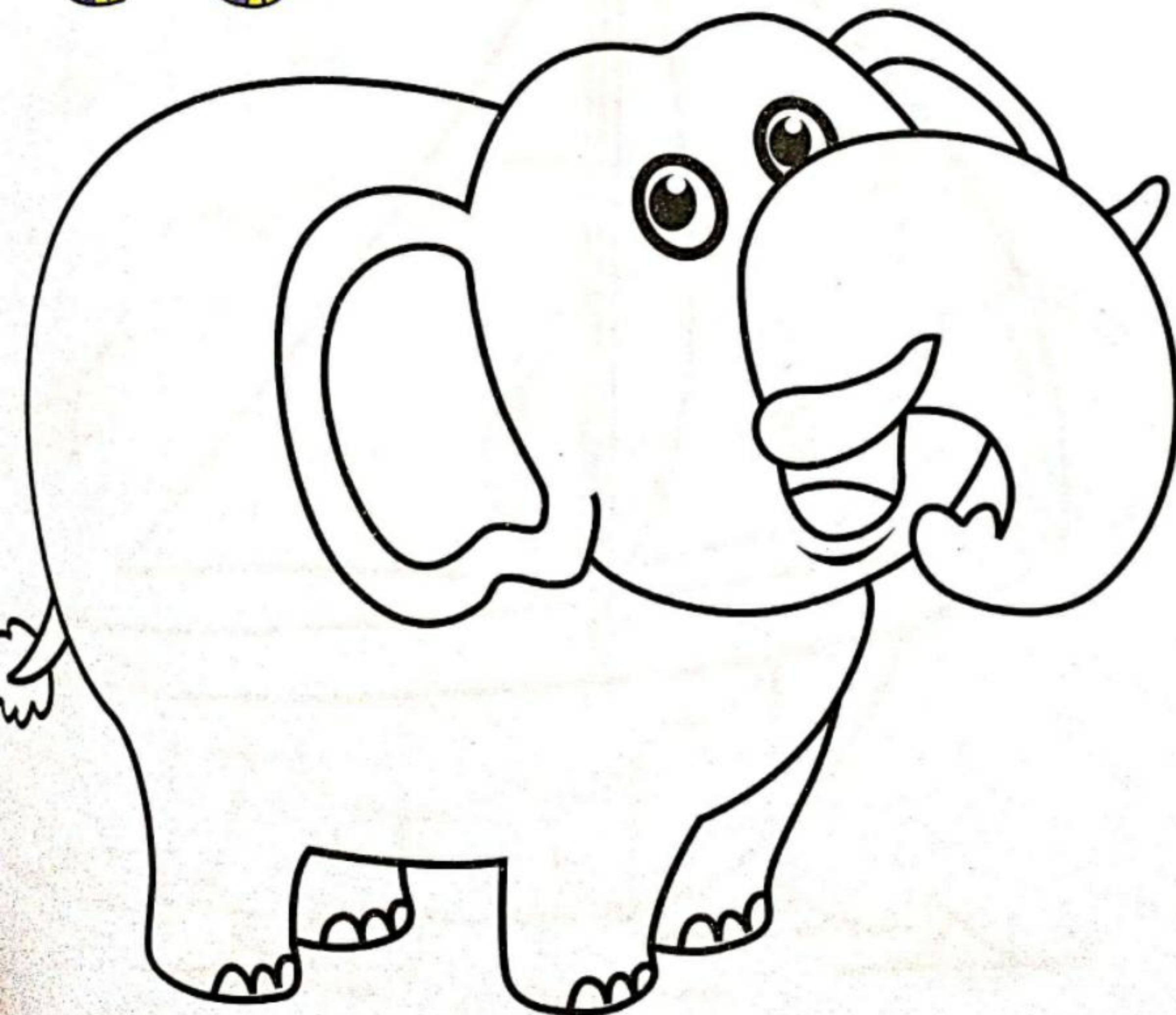
MAJESTIC ELEPHANT

Elephants are the largest mammals that live on land. They are known for their intelligence and gentle attitude.

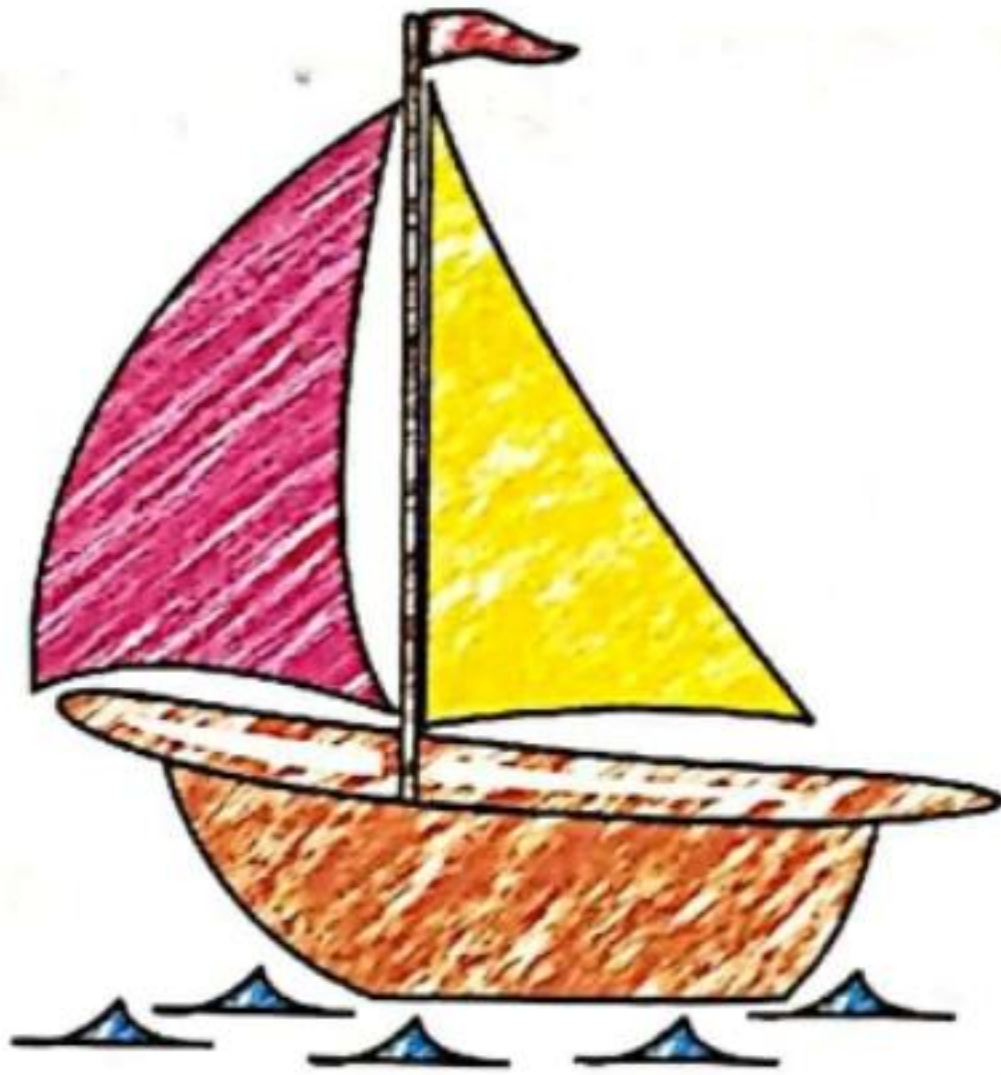
